Judul : Hubungan Tingkat Pengetahuan Dan Kepatuhan Minum Obat Antihipertensi Pada Pasien di Poli Layanan Umum Puskesmas Kecamatan Tanjung Priok Jakarta Utara

Rendahnya pengetahuan dan kepatuhan minum obat hipertensi disebabkan sebagian penduduk tidak menyadari menderita hipertensi atau menganggap remeh hipertensi. Tujuan penelitian untuk mengetahui hubungan pengetahuan dan kepatuhan minum obat hipertensi di Poli Layanan Umum Puskesmas Kecamatan Tanjung Priok Jakarta Utara. Jenis penelitian cross sectional dengan menyebarkan kuesioner kepada penderita hipertensi di Poli Layanan Umum Puskesmas Kecamatan Tanjung Priok. Sampel sebanyak 189 responden. Dianalisis dengan statistic deskriptif dengan aplikasi SPSS. Hasil penelitian 189 responden mayoritas perempuan 120 orang (63,5%), mayoritas usia 46-55 tahun 104 orang (55%). Pekerjaan ibu rumah tangga 73 orang (38,6%). Pendidikan SMA 83 responden (45,9%). Tingkat pengetahuan responden baik 178 orang (94,17%). Tingkat kepatuhan minum obat hipertensi baik 174 orang (92,06%). Menunjukkan ada hubungan yang mempengaruhi antara tingkat pengetahuan dan kepatuhan minum obat hipertensi dengan hasil ($p\text{-value} < 0,000$)

Title : The Level of Knowledge and Compliance taking medication Antyhypertension on patients at Poly Public Service Puskesmas Kecamatan Tanjung Priok North Jakarta

Low knowledge and adherence to taking hypertension medication is caused by some residents not realizing that they suffer from hypertension or underestimate hypertension. The purpose of the study was to determine the relationship between knowledge and adherence to taking hypertension medication at the Public Service Poly Puskesmas Kecamatan Tanjung Priok , North Jakarta. Type of cross-sectional research by distributing questionnaires to people with hypertension at the Public Service Poly Puskesmas Kecamatan Tanjung Priok . A sample of 189 respondents. Analyzed with descriptive statistics with SPSS application. The results of the study were 189 respondents, the majority of whom were women, 120 people (63.5%), the majority aged 46-55 years, 104 people (55%). The employment of housewives is 73 people (38.6%). High school education 83 respondents (45.9%). The knowledge level of respondents was good 178 people (94.17%). The adherence rate of taking hypertension medication is good 174 people (92.06%). Shows there is an influencing relationship between the level of knowledge and adherence to taking hypertension medication outcomes (p-value <0.000)
