

ABSTRAK

Kesehatan Kabupaten Timor Tengah Utara Provinsi Nusa
Tenggara Timur Periode 2014 – 2018.

Sistem katalog elektronik (*E-Catalogue*) merupakan sistem pengadaan obat yang telah berjalan selama 5 tahun menggantikan sistem tender. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui implementasi sistem pengadaan obat berdasarkan katalog elektronik (*E-Catalogue*) di Dinas Kesehatan Kabupaten TTU. Analisis data menggunakan Microsoft excel, berdasarkan pedoman supervisi dan evaluasi obat publik perbekalan kesehatan. Hasil penelitian yaitu pada tahun 2014 persentase total pengadaan obat berdasarkan *e-catalogue* mencapai 90,88% dan non *e-catalogue* 67,81%, tahun 2015 mencapai 94,35%, tahun 2016 83,57% dan non *e-catalogue* di ambil dari dana DAU & DAK 91,71%, tahun 2017 65,64% dan non *e-catalogue* 100%, tahun 2018 73,78% dan non *e-catalogue* 98,01%. Dalam sistem pengadaan obat berdasarkan katalog elektronik Realisasi obat dengan menggunakan sistem *e-catalogue* persentasenya tidak mencapai 100 % bahkan pada tahun 2016 terjadi penurunan tetapi hal ini dapat diatasi oleh pihak Gudang Farmasi Dinas Kesehatan Kabupaten TTU untuk mengadakan obat secara non *e-catalogue* dengan menggunakan biaya APBD II untuk melengkapi kekurangan obat saat pengadaan obat secara *e-catalogue*. maka bisa disimpulkan bahwa ketersediaan obat di Gudang Farmasi Dinas Kesehatan Kabupaten Timor Tengah Utara dapat terpenuhi untuk peningkatan pelayanan kesehatan di Kabupaten Timor Tengah Utara. Kesimpulan penelitian bahwa kendala yang dihadapi seperti Sumber Daya Manusia, sistem dari LKPP, distributor dan lainnya.

ABSTRAC

Electronic catalog system (E-Catalog) is a drug procurement system that has been running for 5 years replacing the tender system. This study aims to determine the implementation of the electronic catalog (E-Catalog) procurement system at TTU District Health Office. Analysis, with Microsoft excel of data based on guidelines supervision and evaluation of public medicines for medical supplies. The results of the study were in 2014 the total percentage of drug procurement based on e-catalog reached 90.88% and non-e-catalog 67.81%, in 2015 it reached 94.35%, in 2016 83.57 % and non-e-catalogs were taken from DAU & DAK funds of 91.71%, in 2017 65.64% and non-e-catalog 100%, in 2018 73.78% and non-e-catalog 98.01% in the system procurement of drugs based on electronic catalog. Realization of drugs using the e-catalog system the percentage does not reach 100% even in 2016 there was a decrease but this can be overcome by the TTU District Health Office Pharmacy Warehouse make drugs in non-e-catalog using APBD II costs to supplement the drug shortages when e-catalog is procured. It can be concluded that the availability of drugs in the Pharmacy Warehouse of the North Central Timor District Health Office can be fulfilled to improve health services in North Timor Tengah District. Conclusion of the study that the obstacles faced such as Human Resources, systems from LKPP, distributors and others.
